Any data collected for the project will be managed and processed by Substance in collaboration with Cefas and the Angling Trust, in accordance with GDPR regulations. By taking part, you are agreeing that data provided in the Volunteer sign-up survey, face-to-face surveys or the Charter Boat survey can be used for the purposes of the Catchwise project and associated research.

All data will be anonymised except for facilitating the operation of the project - such as reminder emails and online support.

Data will be stored securely and no personal information will be passed onto any other party unless you have given express permission for that to be done.

Data will be anonymised and only published in aggregate form for analysis.

We will store your personal data and survey data until December 2026 or as soon as the project and analysis is complete, if sooner.
